# **About Unusual Pet and Avian Veterinarians**

The Unusual Pet and Avian Veterinarians Group was formed in 2013, bringing together two separate veterinary groups which shared similar interests. The group promotes discussion about the medicine and surgery of pet species other than dogs and cats such as lizards, birds, turtles, frogs, native Australian mammals, rabbits, guinea pigs, rats and mice, ferrets and even tarantulas. With changes in licensing laws and people's lifestyles, the choice of family pet might not be a dog or cat, but one of another dozen species. The increase in ownership of unusual pets has resulted in a corresponding need for veterinarians to feel competent with the treatment of pets not traditionally covered in the undergraduate curriculum.

After graduating, he interned at the Avian and Exotic Animal Clinic in Indianapolis. In 1995, he started Arizona's first exclusive exotic animal practice. Currently, he has both a mobile and stationary four doctor practice named The Avian and Exotic Animal Clinic of Arizona". He was a 2016 and 2022 finalist for the Ted Lafeber Practitioner of the Year.

He has spoken internationally Association of Avian Veterinary Conferences (AAV and AAVAC), Association of Reptilian and Amphibian Veterinarians (ARAV) and the Association of Exotic Mammal Veterinarian Veterinary Conferences and Unusual Pet Australian Veterinary conferences. He has authored several chapters in the Veterinary Clinics of North America Exotic Animal Practice and given webinars. He advocates for ethical stewardship of exotic animal care and for animal welfare.

Dr Driggers is involved in many extracurricular activities, including herping, birding, and photography. He raised and distributed over \$75,000 for Australian wildlife carers' and DVM's during the fires and is licensed to practice in 3 Australian territories and the state of Arizona. He has the medical director for mission trips to the Dominican Republic through Food for the Hungry for 14 years overseeing medical, dental, vision, and veterinary practice in a rural setting.

Dr Driggers is a busy father of three and husband to Heather, his high school girlfriend (31 years and counting).


